On October 25, 2018, pursuant to Rule 135c under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the “Securities Act”), Newmark Group, Inc. (NASDAQ: NMRK) (“Newmark” or the “Company”) announced its intention to commence an offering of senior unsecured notes, subject to market conditions and other factors. The notes are to be offered and sold in a private offering exempt from the registration requirements under the Securities Act.

The Company intends to use the net proceeds from the offering to repay outstanding related party debt and intercompany loans owed to or guaranteed by its parent company, BGC Partners, Inc. (NASDAQ: BGCP) (“BGC Partners,” or “BGC”), including the Company’s \$134 million of bank term loan debt. Any additional net proceeds may be used for general corporate purposes.
